

Section I. Husserl and Kant

Since the entire scope of Husserl's oeuvre has, little by little, become visible over the last decades, it has become clear that Husserl deserves to be seen as an integral part of the tradition of Classical German philosophy from Kant to Hegel. Husserl's phenomenology is a most original form of transcendental philosophy that has dealt with all great themes that belong to the main topics of Classical German philosophy. Yet, scholarship on Husserl, apart from hints, has not delved into this relationship in great style and breadth—not yet. Considering Husserl's philosophy as an intrinsic element of the classical German tradition is sure the greatest challenge for the actual Husserl research.

In connection with the Humboldt-Kolleg on the topic "Husserl and Classical German Philosophy" (Parma, March 12-14) young scholars from different countries and of both traditions will discuss some issues that Husserl and German Idealism have investigated and developed in similar or different manners.

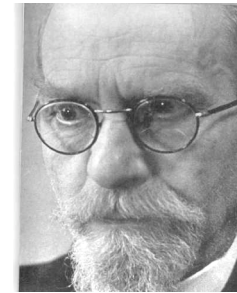
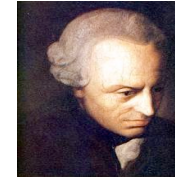
